ETHEL LEE STEADMAN AWARD – presented to the Guild member with longevity and dedicated serve to the COOLJC on the local, state/diocese and international levels. Give a detailed account of this person's service at the three levels. It should be typewritten, presented in a folder or other appropriate format with a picture of the nominee. This award honors the 4th President of the International Guild

ETHEL MAE BONNER AWARD - presented to the state/diocese that present a program which addresses the psychological needs of Ministers and Deacons wives. Be specific with the programs, adding pictures to make your entry very special. Must be typewritten, placed in a scrapbook, folder or other format. Do not allow pictures to be a substitute for the report. This award honors the 3rd President of the International Guild.

DOROTHY GEE RICHARDSON AWARD – presented to the person who exemplifies the most characteristics of faithfulness to education on the local, state, or international level, giving outstanding service and training. Give a typewritten, detailed report on the service of your nominee and a picture of the nominee. This award honors the wife of the late Bishop Thomas J. Richardson who served the COOLJC as treasurer for many years.

CARRIE LAWSON AWARD – presented to the state/diocese with the largest number of registered ministers and deacons wives. The officers will determine the recipient of this award from their official report. This award honors the wife of our Establishmentarian, Bishop Robert C. Lawson

MIRIAM R. NORWOOD BOOK SCHOLARSHIP FUND AWARD – presented to the state/diocese contributing the most of the Book Scholarship Fund. This award honors our 5th President of the International Guild.

MARGARET W. JACKSON APOSTOLIC REVIEW SCHOLARSHIP FUND AWARD - presented to the state/diocese who contributes the most to the Margaret W. Jackson Scholarship Fund. This award honors our 6th President of the International Guild.

Carol A. Coleman Award - presented to a State/Diocese or Local President who has served as President for more that 10 years and has retired from that position. Please submit a typewritten, detailed report of the service of your nominee. This award honors our 7th President of the International Guild.

WALTER LEE JACKSON AWARD – presented to the spouse of a Guild member who contributes the most to the program of the Guild. Give a detailed account of the spouse's service to guild along with a picture of the nominee. This award honors the husband of our 6th International Guild President.
