KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

EVANGELISM AND OUTREACH

- Work in conjunction with the Evangelism ministry to support outreach efforts, focusing on bringing souls to Christ and integrating new female converts into the life of COOLJC.
- Be very observant of potential converts and encourage them to decide to follow Christ.
- Lead initiatives to follow up with new believers and ensure they remain connected with a nurturing spiritual community.

DISCIPLESHIP AND TEACHING

- Create, develop, and lead discipleship programs and Bible studies specifically for women who have been reached through COOLJC evangelistic efforts.
- Teach and train younger women in godly womanhood, homemaking, loving their families, and living a self-controlled, upright, and godly life, as outlined in Titus 2.
- Equip and train other women leaders and volunteers within the ministry to expand the discipleship efforts.
- Work as a liaison between the International Missionary, Women's Council, and Ministers' and Deacons' Wives' Guild in coordinating support of the International Department of Evangelism efforts.



REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- **Spiritual Maturity:** A proven, consistent, and exemplary walk with Jesus Christ. Must be Spirit-filled and respected within the church and community.
- **Biblical Knowledge:** A strong knowledge of the Bible and a commitment to teaching from a scriptural foundation.
- **Leadership and Teaching:** Demonstrated ability to lead, mentor, and teach effectively. Strong interpersonal and communication skills are essential.
- **Character:** Exemplifies the character of a godly woman as described in Titus 2 and is committed to a life of prayer and discipleship.
- **Experience:** Previous experience in church leadership, mentorship, or discipleship is highly valued.
